3mm Bleed

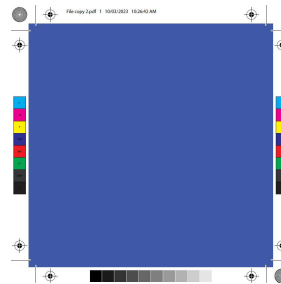

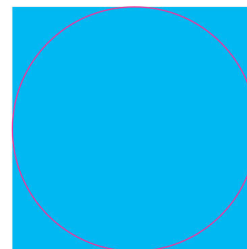

Trimbox size to match quoted size

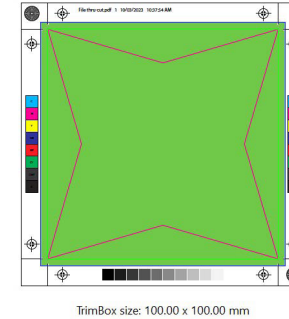


Bleedbox size to incorporate 3mm bleed

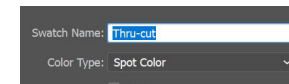

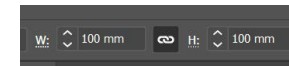
Trimbox size to match quoted size



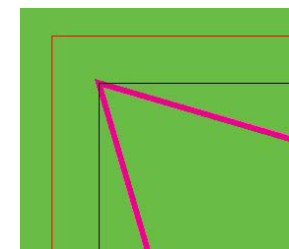
Cutline to be a Spot colour name named Thru-cut



Thru-cut must be a stroke and not a fill

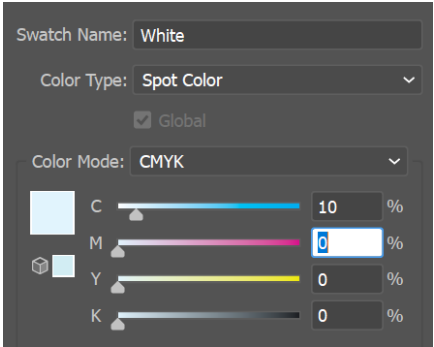


The size of the Thru-cut must match the quoted size

White Ink Guidelines



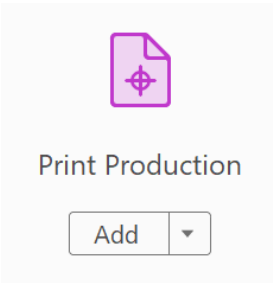
White Ink to be a spot color named White



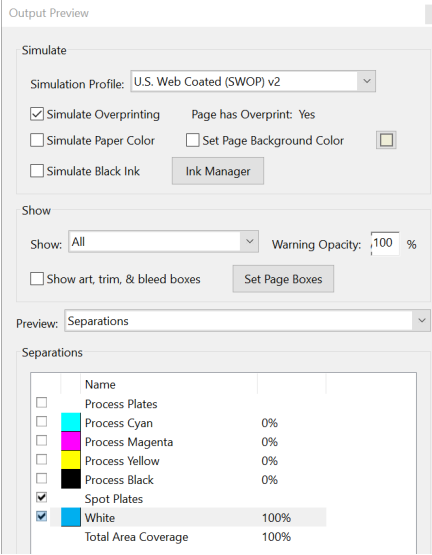
White ink will always print first with CMYK printed over the top.



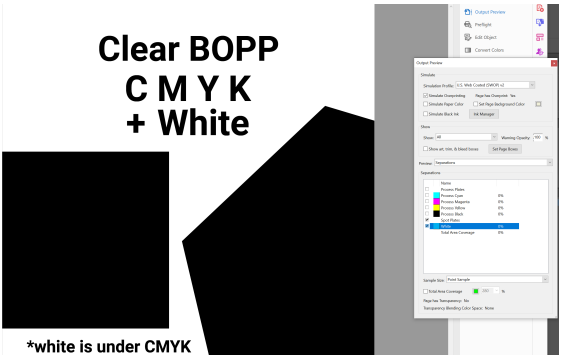
Overprint is honored and must be used depending on artwork setup.



Use Adobe Acrobat print production output preview to vies separations and artwork is correctly setup



Ensure Simulate overprinting is selected.



Select each separation to ensure white ink spot color is correct and that overprint settings are as intended.
